Join grave author and historian Dave Fishell on a fascinating stroll through Fruita's New Elmwood Cemetery.

Discover why years of lawsuits and family arguments plagued the final resting place of Fruita town founder William Pabor. Hear about pioneer Fruita physician Dr. JMG Beard, who mined his own radium for use in some of America's first x-rays. Learn about the infamous gunman and cowboy Charlie Glass, whose accidental death or murder remains unsolved. Find out if some cemetery residents were 'saved by the bell.' All this and much, much more, including a brief talk on headstone art.

New Elmwood Cemetery is located on North Mesa Street, straight north of the Fruita Circle.
