



Regional Opioid Abatement Council Meeting Minutes December 16, 2025

Mr. Crockett emailed the Council on December 16, 2025 to announce that he will be stepping down as Executive Director of Mesa County Public Health at the end of this year. Accordingly, Mr. Crockett stated that he will step down as Chair of Region 13. Mr. Crockett recommended appointing Jenn Daniels for the remainder of his tenure. Mr. Crockett recommended that Ms. Ewara Drews be made a permanent administrator for the Regional Opioid Abatement Council, compensated at 1% out of the total 10% of the Regional Share allocation that is available for administrative expenses. Given the pressing nature and limited availability before year end, Mr. Crockett requested the Board take a vote by email.

Pursuant to the ROAC bylaws regarding actions outside of regular meetings, it was moved by Ms. Daniel and seconded by Ms. McInnis to consider and vote on the following items via email:

1. Chair Appointment:

To appoint Jenn Daniels to serve as Chair of Region 13 for the remainder of the current term.

2. Administrative Support:

To designate Ewara Drews as the permanent administrative support for the Regional Opioid Abatement Council, serving as liaison between Mesa County (fiscal agent) and the ROAC, with compensation set at 1% of the 10% Regional Share allocation available for administrative expenses.
