The Mesa County Regional Opioid Abatement Council (MCROAC) is seeking letters of intent for their Opioid Crisis Recovery Fund grant from agencies focused on recovery, treatment, and prevention and education efforts.

The new grant cycle emphasizes supporting projects that fall under the six MCROAC identified pillars:

- Work Ready
- Connectedness, Peer Support and Recovery, and Community Infrastructure
- Access to Evidence-Based Substance Use Care
- Education, Awareness, and Prevention
- Harm Reduction and Safety
- Post-Event Response, Community Learning, and Healing

The MCROAC facilitated focus groups composed of community experts and individuals with lived experience who formed the community projects under each of these pillars. More information regarding this pillar work and funding priorities can be found on the [MCROAC website](#).

The [letter of intent form](#), also available on the MCROAC website, will be available to **submit July 30-Aug 26, 2026**. The letters of intent will be reviewed by the MCROAC board at their August board meeting and invited agencies may apply during the application window which will end in September.
